

MAJOR ISSUES POLL November 2022

- CLIENT:** Family First New Zealand
- POLL DATES:** Thu 3 to Tue 8 November 2022. The median response was collected on Mon 7 November 2022.
- TARGET POPULATION:** Eligible New Zealand voters.
- SAMPLE POPULATION:** Eligible New Zealand voters who are contactable on a landline or mobile phone or online panel.
- SAMPLE SIZE:** 1,000 respondents agreed to participate – 600 via phone and 400 via online panel.
- SAMPLE SELECTION:** A random selection of 15,000 nationwide phone numbers and a random selection from the online panel.
- WEIGHTING:** The results are weighted to reflect the overall voting adult population in terms of gender, age, and area.
- SAMPLE ERROR:** Based on this sample of 1,200 respondents, the maximum sampling error (for a result of 50%) is +/-3.1%, at the 95% confidence level.
- CODE COMPLIANCE:** This poll was conducted in accordance with the Research Association New Zealand Code of Practice and the International Chamber of Commerce/European Society for Opinion and Market Research Code on Market and Social Research.
