Conservative Party does not believe that bigamy or polygamy are relationships that would benefit New Zealand or the children brought up here so would not support anything other than 1 man, 1 woman marriage.</p>
	<p>This issue should be left to a binding government or citizens initiated referendum after a period of public debate. Polygamy & group marriage – No official policy</p>
	<p>Our policy is not to restore the Marriage Act to one man and one woman only. ACT does not have a policy on (polygamy or) group marriage</p>
	<p>We strongly oppose the reducing of the definition of marriage to being between one man and one woman only. We don't have policy on (polygamy & group marriage) and we have no intention to extend the law to these types of relationships.</p>
	<p>The Māori Party does not have an official policy on supporting or opposing the definition of MARRIAGE being restored to being one man and one woman only. However, we do believe that individuals should have the right to choose. The Māori Party does not have a position on polygamy or group marriage. However, we do support the law of the land and its position on polygamy or group marriage.</p>
