

## Sex Definition Poll May 2025

CLIENT: Family First

POLL DATES: Wednesday 30 April to Sunday 04 May 2025.

The median response was collected on Friday 02 May 2025.

TARGET POPULATION: Adults aged 18+ who live in New Zealand and are eligible and

likely to vote.

SAMPLE POPULATION: Adults aged 18+ who live in New Zealand and are eligible and

likely to vote, who are contactable on a landline or mobile phone

or online panel.

SAMPLE SIZE: 1,000 respondents agreed to participate, 700 by phone and 300 by

online panel.

SAMPLE SELECTION: A random selection of 15,000 NZ phone numbers (landlines and

mobiles) and a random selection from the target population from up to three global online panels (that comply with ESOMAR guidelines for online research). If the call is to a landline, the person who is home and next has a birthday is asked to take part. Those who take part through an online panel are excluded from

further polls on the same topic for six months.

RESPONSE RATE: Multiple call-backs occurred to maximise the response rate. Those

who said they were unlikely or very unlikely to vote were

excluded.

OMNIBUS STATUS: The poll was part of a wider omnibus survey for multiple clients.

The questions were asked in the order they are listed.

WEIGHTING: The results are weighted to reflect the overall voting adult

population in terms of gender, age, and area.

SAMPLE ERROR: Based on this sample of 1,000 respondents, the maximum

sampling error (for a result of 50%) is +/- 3.1%, at the 95% confidence level. Results for sub-groups such as age and area will have a much higher margin of error and not seen as precise.
